Bank of Ogden, of which was pres. 1922-34; pres. First Savings Bank, 1922-34; organized First Security Corp'n. (bank holding co. owning and operating 26 banks in Utah, Ida. and Wyo.), pres., 1927-34; pres. Sego Milk Products Co., Stoddard Lumber Co., Utah Constrn. Co.; pres. Amalgamated Sugar Co.; dir. Mountain States Implement Co., Anderson Lumber Co., Pet Milk Co.; asst. to Sec. of Treasury, 1934; gov. Federal Reserve Bd., 1934-36; chmn. bd. gov's. Federal Reserve System since Feb. 1, 1936, Chmn. Logan City Council of Defense, World War. Chmn. Willard-Farmington Flood Relief Com., 1924. Mem. Utah Bankers' Association (pres. 1924-25), Ogden Chamber of Commerce. Mem.
