BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending October 7, aggregated \$13,456,000,000 or 12 per cent above the total of \$12,025,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York City reported an increase of \$859,000,000, Boston \$157,000,000, Chicago \$35,000,000, St. Louis \$28,000,000, and Pittsburgh \$25,000,000. The largest decrease, \$30,000,000, was reported by Detroit.

As compared with the week ending October 8, 1924, debits for the week under review are larger by \$3,284,000,000, or 32 per cent. Substantial increases are shown for most of the more important centers, the principal increases being as follows: New York City \$2,052,000,000, Chicago \$227,000,000, Boston \$221,000,000, Philadelphia \$94,000,000, Pittsburgh \$78,000,000, San Francisco \$45,000,000, Cleveland \$38,000,000, Detroit \$37,000,000 and St. Louis \$32,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, amounted to about \$12,682,000,000, as compared with \$11,346,627,000 for the preceding week and \$9,516,911,000 for the week ending October 8, 1924.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 253 centers, of which 250 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
