Total industrial production declined 0.5 per cent in December, reflecting a sharp drop in automobile output and reduced use of electricity and gas mainly by residential and commercial users. Excluding motor vehicles and parts and electric and gas utilities, the index rose slightly. The total index, at 126.6 per cent of the 1967 average, was 4.5 per cent above a year earlier.

Auto assemblies in December were at an annual rate of 8.2 million units, down 14.6 per cent from November. Preliminary January output schedules indicate a further decline of about 15 per cent. Production of other consumer durable goods was off slightly in December as output of some household appliances declined. Nondurable consumer goods, excluding the decline in electric and gas utilities, also edged off. Output of business equipment, however, rose .4 per cent to a new high. Production of construction products and steel and other durable and nondurable materials was maintained at about their previous advanced levels.

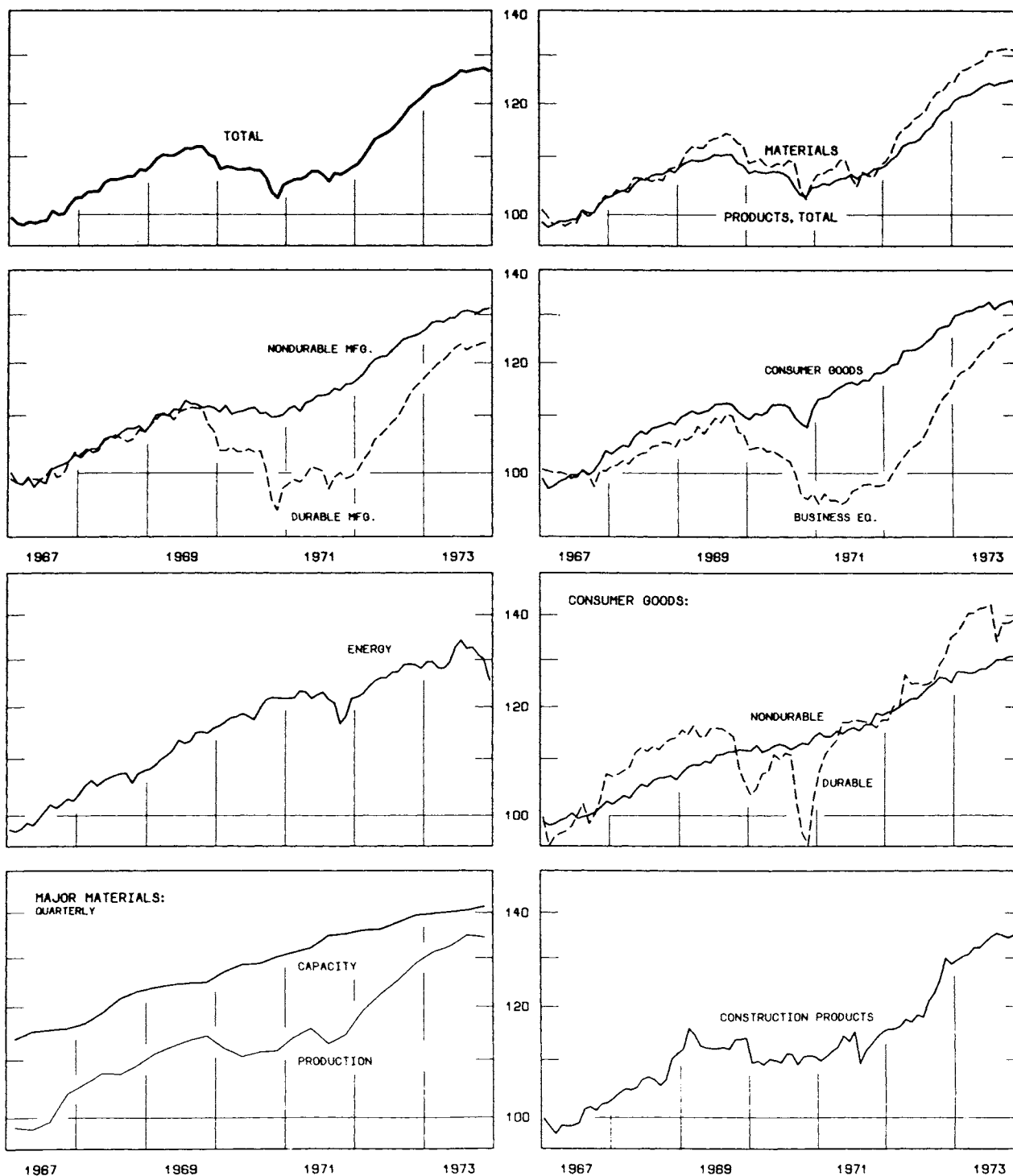
