RETAIL FURNITURE REFORT FOR JANUARY 1962

Instalment and charge account receivables at reporting furniture ctores declined 3 per cent and 5 per cent, respectively, in January. Total receivables were unchanged from a year ago. Collections on instalment accounts were 12 per cent of outstandings at the beginning of the month.

Sales at reporting stores declined seasonally in January but were substantially above the volume in January 1961.
