## BANK DEBITS

Volume of business, as measured by debits to individual accounts, shows an increase from \$7,197,000,000 for the week ending April 13 to \$7,731,000,000 for the week ending April 20, an increase of about 7 per cent. These debits are reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 158 of the country's leading clearing house centers. Larger totals are shown for all the leading centers, except Cleveland, and Minneapolis. An increase of 10 per cent in New York City may be due in part to a larger volume of stock exchange transactions during the week under review.

As compared with the corresponding week in 1920, debits for the week ending April 20 were smaller by \$2,629,000,000, or 25 per cent, decreases being reported for all the leading centers, except Los Angeles.
