BANK DEBITS

Volume of business, as measured by debits to individual accounts reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 155 important clearing house centers for the week ending November 2, shows an increase of \$1,139,000,000, or about 15 per cent, compared with the preceding week's total. This increase may be due in part to end-of-month settlements and in part to more active trading on the New York stock exchange, over three-fourths of the total increase in debits being composed of an increase in New York City. Of the other important centers the majority report increases, though smaller figures are shown for Pittsburgh, New Orleans, Detroit, Minneapolis and Kansas City.

As compared with the week ending November 3, 1920, debits for the week under review show a comparatively slight decrease of \$121,000,000, or 1.4 per cent, this being the smallest lag shown for any week since that ending January 5. Comparison of the leading centers shows that smaller debits this year as compared with last were reported in most cases, though debits for New York, Baltimore, Chicago, San Francisco and Los Angeles were larger than a year ago.
