BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ending April 16, aggregated \$10,307,000,000, or about 10.5 per cent above the total of \$9,329,000,000 reported for the preceding week. Most of the larger centers reported increases over last week's figures. New York City reported an increase of about \$428,000,000, Philadelphia - an increase of \$104,000,000, Cleveland - an increase of \$63,000,000, and Detroit - an increase of \$56,000,000.

As compared with the corresponding period in 1923, debits for the week under review show a decrease of \$55,000,000 or about one half of one per cent. Decreases of about \$37,000,000 each were reported for Boston and Chicago, while increases of \$53,000,000 and \$28,000,000, respectively, were reported for Cleveland and Philadelphia.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were \$9,672,776,000 as compared with \$8,753,220,000 for the preceding week and \$9,719,107,000 for the week ending April 18, 1923.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 254 centers, of which 248 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
