BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending August 18, aggregated \$11,602,000,000 or 1.4 per cent below the total of \$11,770,000,000 reported for the preceding week.

Debits for the week under review are \$816,000,000 or 7.6 per cent above those for the week ending August 19, 1925. New York City reported an increase of \$471,000,000, while other large increases were as follows: Chicago \$94,000,000, Los Angeles \$32,000,000, San Francisco \$26,000,000, and Cleveland \$19,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919, amounted to \$10,890,631,000, as compared with \$11,084,338,000 for the preceding week and \$10,119,672,000 for the week ending August 19, 1925.
