BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended February 21, aggregated \$7,324,000,000, or 24 per cent above the total reported for last week, which included only five business days in many of the reporting cities.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to about \$6,873,000,000, compared with \$5,482,000,000 last week.
