BANK DEBITS

Board of Governors
of the Federal Reserve System
February 29, 1936

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended February 26, which included only five business days, aggregated \$7,677,000,000, or 11 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 16 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year, which also included only five business days.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,177,000,000, compared with \$7,976,000,000 the preceding week and \$5,172,000,000 the week ended February 27 of last year.
