BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended November 25, aggregated \$10,045,000,000, or 10 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 17 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$9,365,000,000, compared with \$10,338,000,000 the preceding week and \$7,984,000,000 the week ended November 27 of last year.
