Demand peposits

For immediate release May 22, 1969.

The seasonally adjusted money supply increased \$1.1 billion in the week ending May 14. Over the first two weeks of May the average level is estimated at \$194.5 billion compared with \$194.0 billion in March and \$195.7 billion in April. Time and savings deposits increased slightly in the latest week, but for the first two weeks of May these deposits averaged about \$700 million lower than in the month of April.
