At the meeting of the Board on October 8, 1948, following a report by Chairman McCabe and Mr. Evans on their conversations with Mr. Stewart, General Counsel for Transamerica Corporation, it was the consensus that in view of the expressed intention of Transamerica to take the matter of the Board's complaint under the Clayton Act into the courts, if Mr. Stewart or other attorneys for the Corporation called again for an appointment with Chairman McCabe or any other member of the Board, he would be informed that inasmuch as the matter had gotten into the courts he should confine his conferences to meetings with the Board's Counsel.
