The volume of business under Title I for the week ending November 16th, reached the new and all time high of 28,253 modernization and repair loans for an aggregate of \$8,670,067.


The total of both Titles for the week was \$14,271,208, or the second highest week in the history of the Administration, and almost equal to the record.

NEW RESIDENTIAL BUILDING




