

My dear Mr. Eccles:

I wish to confirm my telegram of September 23, 1946, inviting you to be present as one of my advisers during the forthcoming meetings of the Boards of Governors of the International Bank and the International Monetary Fund.

In order that the United States may be effectively represented on the several committees, I hereby designate you as my temporary alternate and the United States member on certain of the functioning committees of the respective Boards. Under the tentative schedule of United States representation on Fund and Bank committees you would be my temporary alternate and the United States member on the Committee on Rules and Regulations of the Fund and on the Committee on Rules and Regulations of the Bank. In this capacity you will have several United States advisers familiar with the problems with which these Committees will be concerned.
