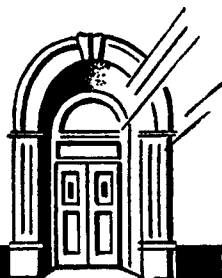

Dear Mr. Eccles:


I am delighted that you find it possible to address the members of the City Club at noon on Saturday, April 21st.
