Report of Superintendent of Banks

Salem, Oregon, January 1, 1914.

To the Honorable State Banking Board:

Gentlemen: In accordance with the provisions of Section 4581 of the Laws of this State, relating to banking, I beg to submit herewith the Sixth Annual Report of this Department.

Having so recently assumed the duties of Superintendent of Banks and my connection with the Department, as an Examiner, being of such a short duration, I have not had the opportunity of sufficiently familiarizing myself with general conditions and the workings of the office so as to make an intelligent summary of banking conditions throughout the State. This report, therefore, will necessarily be confined principally to figures and tables compiled from the records of the office.

I wish to take this opportunity of calling special attention to the credit that is due my able predecessor, Mr. Will Wright, for his conscientious and most efficient administration during the past three and one-half years. Through his untiring energy, excellent judgment and able supervision, the Department has reached a high state of efficiency and the banking conditions throughout the State have been greatly strengthened and improved. In administering the affairs of the office, it shall be my endeavor to follow as nearly as possible the policies inaugurated by Mr. Wright, and I trust that my efforts will not be in vain, but that the high standard of the Department, already established, will be maintained.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF BANKING BUSINESS.

At the date of the last official call, October 21, 1913, there were one hundred and seventy State, Savings, Private and Foreign banks under the supervision of this Department, with total Resources aggregating \$74,086,277.62. The statement which appears in this Report as Table I gives items in detail and compares conditions with that as shown at date of the corresponding call of last year, November 26, 1912.

Since the last Report of the Department, there has been a decrease of one in the total number of banks, through voluntary

liquidation, consolidation and nationalization, yet a net gain of \$607,391.96 is shown in banking capital, through increase of capital and surplus. Deposits in the State banks at date of last call, October 21, 1913, exclusive of Postal Savings Deposits, amounted to \$59,396,237.49, while the total cash on hand and balances due from banks was \$19,679,588.98, making an average reserve of a little over 33 per cent. Total deposits, compared with corresponding call of November 26, 1912, show an increase of \$94,747.00. The combined statement of all banks in the State shows an increase in deposits of \$7,084,558.24, which would indicate a most substantial growth in the banking business and a healthy general condition throughout the State. In fact, a careful analysis of the individual statements of the banks, under this date, considering class of investments, percentage of reserves, etc., reveals the most satisfactory condition in the history of the Department.

Banking conditions in general have been somewhat strengthened during the year, through voluntary liquidation, consolidation, reorganization and transfer of business. The Department has refused to grant a number of charters, for various reasons. In some instances investigation has shown clearly that the organization was for the purpose of satisfying personal differences or to further the interests of the promoters, but in most cases charters were refused for the reason the field was already sufficiently served and the business too limited for the establishment of another bank in the community.

It has been the experience of the Department that one successfully managed bank, in a community of a limited amount of deposits, can serve the public to a better advantage and with greater safety to its depositors, than where the business is divided between two or more smaller institutions, making the business unprofitable to them all.

NEW BANKS AND CHANGE IN CAPITAL.

During the year eleven banks have been incorporated and authorized to commence business, with a capitalization of \$840,000.00. Of this number, two were already doing business as private banks. Four banks have increased their capital a total of \$77,500.00, while two have decreased their capital a total of \$40,000.00. Tables A, B and C of this Report show the names of new banks authorized and the names of banks increasing and decreasing capital.

BANKS DISCONTINUING BUSINESS.

Since the last Report of this Department, eleven banks under its supervision have discontinued business, by transferring their deposits to other banks and going into voluntary liquidation, one has nationalized and there has been one consolidation. Tables D, E and F of this Report give the names of the banks nationalizing, consolidating and discontinuing business.

BANKS IN CHARGE OF DEPARTMENT, FOR LIQUIDATION.

First State Bank of Philomath.—During the past year progress has been made in the liquidation of the above named bank and an additional dividend of 20% paid depositors.

Adjustments of suits reported in last Report of this Department were effected and settlement of other assets secured. At this time there remains on hand funds applicable to payment of dividends, but until an amount sufficient to pay at least 10% is recovered the Department is not justified in making a distribution.

The final liquidation will have to await settlement of the affairs of the Philomath Creamery Co., now in charge of Trustee in bankruptcy, and payment of balance due from the Noon Lumber Co. No distribution has been made by the Trustee to creditors of the first named concern. It was estimated that the bank should recover about \$2,350.00 from this source. The indebtedness of the Noon Lumber Co. is secured and there is a balance due of \$5,252.31.

Depositors have been paid total dividends of 80%; and a statement of the affairs of said bank, as shown by the books in charge of this Department, is made a part of this Report.

American Bank & Trust Co., of Portland.—Liquidation of the affairs of this bank has progressed slowly and little has been accomplished during the past year. Efforts to secure set-

tlement of loans considered collectible have brought small results and most of said notes now appear to be very doubtful.

Suits have been instituted to determine liability of former stockholders of said bank. None of such suits have yet been brought to trial and it is not possible to ascertain when hearings will be had.

Since the first of January, 1913, the liquidation has been conducted through this office, thus eliminating all expense for office rent, clerical assistance, etc.

No further dividends have been paid depositors during the past year and the funds on hand are insufficient to justify a distribution at this time.

A statement of the affairs of said bank, as shown by the books of this Department, is made a part of this report.

Bank of Troutdale, Troutdale.—The business of this bank was placed in charge of this Department, for liquidation, February 25, 1913. After taking possession of said bank, negotiations were entered into with other banks to take over the deposits. On March 14, 1913, arrangements were completed, whereby all deposits were transferred to The Citizens Bank, of Portland, and all depositors paid in full. The balance of the bank's assets were returned to the directors, for liquidation, for the benefit of the stockholders.

PUBLISHED REPORTS OF CONDITION

During the year, five calls for reports of condition have been made, upon the dates named by the Comptroller of the Currency, for National banks, namely: February 4th; April 4th; June 4th; August 9th; October 21st. There will be found annexed, as a part of this Report, a statement of every bank reporting to this department, under date of October 21, 1913, same being the last official call for the year.

NEW LEGISLATION

The 1913 Legislative Assembly, besides enacting several amendments to the laws relating to banking, passed what is known as Senate Bill No. 219, being an Act to provide for the incorporation and organization, regulation, liquidation and supervision of trust companies and the regulation of banks authorized to do the business of a trust company, and placing supervision in the hands of this department.

At this Assembly, House Bill No. 122 also became a law. This is an Act to regulate the business of loaning money or

credit by persons, firms and corporations, other than National banks, licensed bankers, real estate brokers and pawnbrokers. The regulation and supervision of the business of those concerns was also placed with the department.

TRUST COMPANIES

Under the provisions of the new law, existing corporations have until the 4th day of June, 1914, in which to comply with all the requirements of the Act. At date of this Report, only one company has qualified and one new corporation has been organized, under the Act, making a total of two now doing business under supervision of the department.

The law provides that no person, firm, co-partnership, association or corporation, which has not complied with the provisions of the Act, shall be permitted to use in the name or title, under which the business is transacted, the words "Trust" or "Trustee." This provision of the Act affects thirteen State banks, two of which, not caring to qualify as trust companies, have already filed supplementary articles of incorporation, changing their names and eliminating the objectionable words.

The law also requires that every trust company in the State shall annually, during the month of January, file with the Superintendent of Banks a statement, under oath, as of the 31st day of December next preceding, giving a list of all trusts accepted or held by it, character, source and date of appointment, the parcels of real estate held in each and the amount and character of personal property held in each. These reports are also to include such other information as the Superintendent of Banks may prescribe or require; but, owing to the fact that only two corporations have qualified under the Act, and it being the desire of the department to adopt forms that will meet the requirements of all the companies that expect to qualify and transact business in accordance with the provisions, blanks for the reports have not yet been compiled. However, in order to meet the requirements of the law, the two existing corporations have been requested to file statements, on forms to be compiled by themselves, so as to cover the items required and their own particular class of business.

LOAN COMPANIES AND INDIVIDUALS LOANING MONEY

The recently enacted law, regulating the loaning of money and credits, provides an annual license fee of \$50.00 and the filing of a surety bond, in the sum of \$1,000.00, conditioned upon a faithful compliance with the law of the State relating

to the business of the applicant. At date of this Report, one license has been granted and two applications are now on file, awaiting the consideration of the Board.

Several complaints for violations of the law have been filed with the department during the year and investigations were made, but as yet no convictions have been secured. Several cases are now in the hands of the District Attorney for attention; and it will be the endeavor of the department to enforce a strict compliance with the requirements of the law.

THE NEW CURRENCY BILL

The Federal Reserve Act, which has recently become a law, will in all probability necessitate several amendments to our State Banking Laws, otherwise banks operating under State supervision will be placed at a disadvantage. In reading over the bill, as finally passed, and in the discussion of same with different State bankers, several changes in our State laws have already been suggested, and no doubt others will follow, as the law becomes operative.

CONCLUSION

In conclusion, I wish to commend every member of the department force for faithful and efficient work. I also wish to take this opportunity of thanking the bank officers and clerks throughout the State for the uniform courtesy and assistance extended representatives of this office. The department wants the co-operation and good will of every banker in the State; and it shall be my endeavor at all times to bring about a complete understanding with each bank, for, in order to accomplish the good we all seek, perfect harmony must exist between the banks and the department.
