New Counterfeit \$20 Federal Reserve Note

*To all Banks, Trust Companies and Savings Banks
in the Second Federal Reserve District:*

The Treasury Department in its circular letter No. 493 describes a new counterfeit \$20 Federal Reserve note as follows:

“On the Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland, Ohio (4-E), series 1914; check letter ‘B’; face plate 114; D. F. Houston, Secretary of the Treasury; John Burke, Treasurer of the United States; portrait of Cleveland.

“This is a photographic production on two pieces of paper between which silk threads have been distributed. The number of the counterfeit at hand is D15152890A, the figures of which have been traced over with blue ink. Green coloring has been applied to the back of the bill, but the general appearance of the counterfeit is deceptive.”
