New Counterfeit \$20 Gold Certificate

*To all Banks, Trust Companies and Savings Banks
in the Second Federal Reserve District:*

The Treasury department in its circular letter No. 539 describes a new counterfeit \$20 Gold Certificate as follows:

“Series of 1922; check letter ‘C’; plate number indistinct, but looks like 15, H. V. Spillman, Register of the Treasury; Frank White, Treasurer of the United States; portrait of Washington.

“This counterfeit appears to have been printed from lithograph plates on two pieces of paper, between which a few silk threads have been distributed. The general appearance of the face of the bill is deceptive, but the portrait of Washington is rough and generally poorly executed. The back of the bill is red instead of yellow. Care should be exercised in the handling of bills of this description.”
