Results of Election of Directors

The election by member banks of Group 2, Second Federal Reserve District, of two directors of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, has resulted in the choice of Mr. ROBERT H. TREMAN, of Ithaca, N. Y., as a Class A director, and Mr. THEODORE F. WHITMARSH, of New York, N. Y., as a Class B director, each for a term of three years from January 1, 1927.
