## Exchange Subscription Books to Close December 2, 1933

### On Offering of United States of America Treasury Bonds of 1943-45

*To all Banks and Trust Companies in the Second  
Federal Reserve District and Others Concerned:*

In accordance with instructions from the Treasury Department the subscription books for the offering of United States of America Treasury bonds of 1943-45, dated and bearing interest from October 15, 1933, due October 15, 1945, which were closed on October 17, 1933 for the receipt of cash subscriptions, will close at the close of business Saturday, December 2, 1933 for the receipt of *exchange subscriptions* in payment of which Fourth Liberty Loan 4 $\frac{1}{4}$  per cent bonds of 1933-38, whether or not called for redemption, are tendered.

All such exchange subscriptions actually mailed before midnight, Saturday, December 2, 1933, as shown by post office cancellation, will be considered as having been entered before the close of the subscription books.
