

# Resampling of Industries

Effective with this report, another set of resampled industries is introduced. Three mining, 28 manufacturing, and 3 service industries were resampled this month. Indexes for these industries appear in table 5.

Under the resampling procedure, the sample for an in-

dustry is updated to reflect changes in the structure, membership, technology, or product mix of an industry. The Bureau of Labor Statistics published the first results of this systematic process in July 1986. Subsequent efforts have been completed at 6-month intervals.

**E**ffective with the publication of data for July 2000, the Producer Price Index (PPI) includes data for 13 re-sampled industries. The Bureau of Labor Statistics periodically updates the sample of producers providing data for the PPI to more accurately reflect current conditions when the structure, membership, technology, or product mix of an industry shifts significantly. The first results of this systematic process were published in July 1986. Subsequent efforts have been completed at 6-month intervals. As part of an ongoing effort to expand coverage to sectors of the economy other than mining and manufacturing, seven industries are being introduced into the PPI for the first time.
