

NAICS Conversion

The net output price indexes will be converted from the 1987 Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) basis to the 2002 North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) basis with the February 2004 release of January 2004 indexes. The NAICS conversion involves major definitional changes to many of the currently published SIC-based indexes. After the conversion to NAICS, SIC-based indexes will no longer be produced or published. Historical

index data based on the NAICS publication structure will be available depending on the scope of the definitional changes between SIC and NAICS.

With the release of indexes for January 2004, the net output price indexes were converted from the 1987 Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) basis to the 2002 North American Industry Classification System (NAICS). Historical index data based on the NAICS publication structure are available depending on the scope
