## No. 8.—ESTIMATED POPULATION ON JULY 1, BY STATES: 1931 TO 1942

[Figures for 1931 to 1939 are revised estimates based on 1930 and 1940 census figures, State census figures for States which had State censuses, birth and death data, migration data from the 1940 census, and other available local data, such as school census and school enrollment figures. Estimates for 1940 to 1942 are based on the 1940 census, on registrations for War Ration Book One, and on estimated births, deaths, and migration after Apr. 1, 1940. For each year, State figures have been adjusted to add to an independent estimate of population of the United States, based on 1930 and 1940 censuses and on annual data on births, deaths, immigration, and emigration.
