## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts for the week ending December 26 aggregated \$8,653,000,000 or about 20 per cent less than the total of \$10,781,000,000 reported for the preceding week. The unusually large decrease is due in part to the fact that the previous week's figures were augmented by the December 15 income and profits tax payments and to the fact that the week under review included Christmas day and therefore contained but five business days. All of the more important centers, except Pittsburgh and Detroit, report large declines. New York City reports a reduction of \$1,200,000,000, Boston - \$109,000,000, Chicago \$101,000,000, Philadelphia - \$58,000,000 and San Francisco - \$49,000,000.

As compared with the corresponding period in 1922, which also included Christmas day, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$835,000,000 or of about 11 per cent. Larger figures are reported for most of the leading centers. New York City shows an increase of \$581,000,000, Los Angeles - \$39,000,000, Chicago - \$34,000,000, and Boston and Detroit - \$32,000,000 each.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 249 centers, of which 241 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
