## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts for the week ending January 2 aggregated \$10,704,000,000 or about 24 per cent over the total of \$8,669,000,000 reported for the preceding week. Both the current and preceding weeks included but five business days. The increase is largely due to the heavy end-of-month and end-of-year payments. All of the more important centers, except Detroit and St. Paul, report comparatively large increases. New York City reports an increase of \$1,103,000,000, Chicago-an increase of \$180,000,000, Cleveland - an increase of \$101,000,000 and Philadelphia - an increase of \$99,000,000.

As compared with the corresponding period a year ago debits for the week under review show a decrease of \$861,000,000 or of about 7 per cent. Smaller figures are reported for most of the leading centers including New York City, Pittsburgh and St. Louis.

Aggregate debits for the 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were \$10,059,307,000 as compared with \$8,131,332,000 for the preceding week and \$10,916,728,000, for the week ending January 3, 1923.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 250 centers, of which 244 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
