## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts for the week ending January 9 aggregated \$10,520,000,000 or \$180,000,000 less than the total of \$10,700,000,000 reported for the preceding week, which included but five business days. New York City reports a decrease of \$102,000,000, Chicago - a decrease of \$100,000,000, Cleveland - a decrease of \$61,000,000 and Cincinnati - a decrease of \$40,000,000. The largest increase, \$18,000,000, is reported for Los Angeles.

As compared with the corresponding period in 1923, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$250,000,000 or of about 2.4 per cent. Increases are shown for most of the leading centers. New York City reports an increase of \$68,000,000, Los Angeles - an increase of \$41,000,000, and Boston - an increase of \$33,000,000.

Aggregate debits for the 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were \$9,865,784,000 as compared with \$10,059,307,000 for the preceding week and \$9,642,162,000, for the week ending January 10, 1923.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 252 centers, of which 245 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
