BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts for the week ending January 23 aggregated \$10,000,000 or \$680,000,000 less than the total of \$10,445,000,000 reported for preceding week. Most of the leading centers report smaller figures than for week before. New York City shows a decrease of \$382,000,000, Chicago - a decrease of \$41,000,000, and New Orleans - a decrease of \$21,000,000. Detroit shows a decrease of about \$20,000,000.

As compared with the corresponding period in 1923, debits for the week show an increase of \$231,000,000. Larger figures are reported by many of the leading centers. New York City shows an increase of \$194,000,000, Detroit - an increase of \$40,000,000, and Los Angeles - an increase of \$36,000,000. Decreased debits amounting to \$27,000,000 and \$13,000,000, respectively, are reported for Chicago and Cleveland.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for week in 253 centers, of which 246 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
