BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts for the week ending January 30 aggregated \$25,000,000 or \$242,000,000 less than the total of \$9,767,000,000 reported for the previous week. Most of the leading centers report smaller figures than for the week before. Detroit shows a decrease of \$37,000,000, Boston - a decrease of \$4,000,000, and New York City - a decrease of \$22,000,000. Philadelphia shows an increase of \$25,000,000.

As compared with the corresponding period in 1923, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$190,000,000. Larger figures are reported by most of the leading centers. New York City shows an increase of \$179,000,000, Los Angeles an increase of \$32,000,000, and Philadelphia - an increase of \$20,000,000. A decrease of about \$23,000,000 is reported by Cleveland.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were \$8,983,955,000 as compared with \$9,193,755,000 for the preceding week and \$8,790,982,000 for the week ending January 31, 1923.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for reports in 254 centers, of which 247 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
