## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ending February 13 aggregated \$8,521,000,000 or \$1,884,000,000 less than the total of \$10,405,000,000 reported for the preceding week. Most of the larger cities show declines as compared with the previous week's figures. New York City reports a decrease of \$1,303,000,000, Philadelphia - a decrease of \$79,000,000, Boston - a decrease of \$46,000,000, and Cleveland - a decrease of \$33,000,000.

As compared with the corresponding period of 1923, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$47,000,000. The principal increases are reported for Los Angeles, San Francisco, Boston and New Orleans, and the principal decreases for New York City and Philadelphia.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were \$8,011,128,000 as compared with \$9,816,622,000 for the preceding week and \$7,980,763,000 for the week ending February 14, 1923.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for weeks in 255 centers, of which 247 are included in the summary by Federal Reserve Districts.
