BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ending April 2, aggregated \$10,420,000,000, or about 6 per cent above the total of \$9,840,000,000 reported for the preceding week. Most of the larger centers report increases. New York City reports an increase of \$205,000,000, Chicago - an increase of \$50,000,000, Boston - an increase of \$35,000,000, and Cleveland - an increase of \$30,000,000. The largest decrease, \$32,000,000, is shown for Detroit.

As compared with the corresponding period in 1923, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$304,000,000 or 3 per cent. New York City reports an increase of \$344,000,000, and New Orleans - an increase of \$28,000,000. Decreases of \$23,000,000 and \$17,000,000 are shown for Boston and Cleveland, respectively.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were \$9,818,894,000 as compared with \$9,296,114,000 for the preceding week and \$9,507,035,000 for the week ending April 4, 1923.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for the week in 255 centers, of which 248 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
