## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ending May 28, aggregated \$9,104,000,000 or about 8.4 per cent below the total of \$9,835,000,000 reported for the preceding week. All of the more important centers report smaller figures than for the earlier week, which contained the usual heavy month payments. New York City reports a decline of \$372,000,000, Detroit a decline of \$50,000,000 and Boston - a decline of \$30,000,000.

As compared with the corresponding week of 1923, which included May 30, observed as a holiday in most districts, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$2,244,000,000 or of 16 per cent. New York City shows an increase of \$861,000,000, Chicago - an increase of \$59,000,000 and Philadelphia - an increase of \$46,000,000, while smaller increases are reported for most of the other larger centers.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were about \$8,603,000,000 as compared with \$9,380,684,000 for the preceding week and \$7,384,239,000 for the week ending May 30, 1923.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for the week ending May 28, 1924, in 250 centers, of which 243 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
