BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ending July 30, aggregated \$9,340,000,000 or .8 per cent below the total of \$17,000,000 reported for the previous week. Most of the larger centers reported smaller figures than for a week earlier. New York City reports an increase of \$22,000,000 and Pittsburgh - an increase of \$15,000,000. Decreases of \$47,000,000 for Detroit and of \$44,000,000 for Chicago are also shown.

As compared with the week ending August 1, 1923, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$635,000,000 or 7.3 per cent. An increase of \$787,000,000 reported by banks in New York City and an increase of \$12,000,000 - by banks in Orleans. Chicago reports a decline of \$46,000,000, Cleveland - a decline of \$3,000,000 and Baltimore, - a decline of \$16,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were \$8,828,259,000 as compared with \$8,869,645,000 for the preceding week and \$8,190,172,000 for the week ending August 1, 1923.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 253 centers, of which 242 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
