BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ending September 3, aggregated \$8,269,000,000 or 8.6 per cent below the total of \$9,046,000,000 reported for the preceding week. The decrease in debits due to the holiday on September 1 was more than sufficient to offset the usual end of month increase. New York City reports a decline in debits of \$610,000,000, Chicago - of \$48,000,000, Detroit - of \$40,000,000, Boston and Pittsburgh of \$29,000,000. Increases of \$22,000,000 and \$13,000,000, respectively, are shown for San Francisco and Minneapolis.

As compared with the week ending September 5, 1923, which was also a five-day week, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$862,000,000 or 11.6 per cent. New York City reports an increase of \$743,000,000, Chicago - an increase of \$69,000,000, Boston - an increase of \$26,000,000 and Philadelphia - an increase of \$21,000,000. The largest decrease, \$16,000,000 is shown for Pittsburgh.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were \$7,797,333,000 as compared with \$8,553,734,000 for the preceding week and \$6,940,618,000 for the week ending September 5, 1923.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 254 centers, of which 244 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
