BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts for the week ending October 8, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities, aggregated \$10,123,000,000 or 4.5 per cent less than the total of \$10,605,000,000 shown for the previous week. New York City reports a decline of \$569,000,000, Chicago - a decline of \$33,000,000, and Boston and Philadelphia - declines of \$16,000,000 each. Increases of \$19,000,000 and \$15,000,000 respectively, were reported by Minneapolis and Los Angeles.

As compared with the week ending October 10, 1923, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$978,000,000 or 10.7 per cent. Most of the important centers report increases for the year; New York City reports an increase of \$535,000,000, Chicago - an increase of \$40,000,000, Minneapolis - an increase of \$30,000,000 and Boston - an increase of \$35,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were \$9,516,911,000 as compared with \$10,030,554,000 for the preceding week and \$8,577,180,000 for the week ending October 10, 1923.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 253 centers, of which 242 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
