## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities, aggregated \$9,860,000,000 or 8.4 per cent less than the total of \$10,761,000,000 reported for the preceding week. Declines are shown for most of the more important centers except Pittsburgh. New York City reports a reduction of \$307,000,000, Chicago - of \$31,000,000, Boston - of \$77,000,000, Detroit - of \$37,000,000 and San Francisco - of \$27,000,000.

As compared with the week ending October 31, 1923, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$556,000,000 or 6 per cent. New York City reports an increase of \$440,000,000, Minneapolis - an increase of \$33,000,000, Boston, an increase of \$29,000,000 and New Orleans - an increase of \$20,000,000. Decreases of \$27,000,000 for Cleveland and of \$15,000,000 each for San Francisco and Los Angeles are also reported.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919, were \$9,315,020,000 as compared with \$10,139,857,000 for the preceding week and \$8,757,237,000 for the week ending October 31, 1923.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 252 centers, of which 241 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
