BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities, aggregated \$10,448,000,000 or 5.8 per cent above the total of \$9,873,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York City reports an increase of \$439,000,000, Boston of \$80,000,000, Chicago of \$18,000,000 and Cleveland of \$17,000,000. Declines of \$17,000,000 are reported for Philadelphia and of \$11,000,000 each for San Francisco and Los Angeles.

As compared with the week ending November 7, 1923, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$1,084,000,000 or 11.6 per cent. New York City reports an increase of \$1,031,000,000, Boston of \$26,000,000, Pittsburgh of \$24,000,000 and Minneapolis of \$21,000,000. Decreases of \$22,000,000 for Los Angeles of \$18,000,000 for San Francisco and of \$16,000,000 for New Orleans are also shown.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were \$9,857,802,000 as compared with \$9,315,020,000 for the preceding week and \$8,794,701,000 for the week ending November 7, 1923.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 254 centers, of which 246 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
