## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities, aggregated \$11,378,000,000 or 7.9 per cent below the total of \$12,358,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York City reports a reduction of \$620,000,000, San Francisco of \$44,000,000, Cleveland of \$42,000,000 and Boston of \$38,000,000. Philadelphia reports an increase of \$28,000,000, Detroit of \$22,000,000, and Pittsburgh of \$19,000,000.

As compared with the week ending December 26, 1923, which included only five business days, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$2,723,000,000 or 31.5 per cent. The largest increases are as follows: New York City \$1,801,000,000, Chicago \$173,000,000, Philadelphia \$122,000,000, Boston \$90,000,000 and Detroit \$37,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were about \$10,738,000,000 as compared with \$11,678,816,000 for the preceding week and \$8,131,332,000 for the week ending December 26, 1923.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 248 centers, of which 240 are included in the summary by Federal reserve district.
