## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending February 18, aggregated \$10,725,000, or 4.3 per cent below the total of \$11,210,000,000 reported for the preceding week. The week included but five business days for most of the leading centers on account of the holiday on February 12, which more than offset the usual midmonth swell of debits. New York City reports a reduction of \$463,000,000. Other large reductions are as follows: Pittsburgh \$50,000,000, Chicago \$45,000,000, Minneapolis \$21,000,000, Boston \$17,000,000 and Los Angeles \$15,000,000. The largest increase \$16,000,000 was reported for Detroit.

As compared with the week ending February 20, 1924, which contained six business days, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$249,000,000 or 2.4 per cent. New York City reports an increase of \$235,000,000, Boston of \$38,000,000, St. Louis of \$16,000,000 and Minneapolis of \$14,000,000. Decreases are shown for the following cities: Los Angeles \$43,000,000, Cleveland and Chicago \$17,000,000 each, and Philadelphia and New Orleans \$16,000,000 each.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, aggregated \$10,096,491,000 as compared with \$10,591,710,000 for the preceding week and \$9,870,701,000 for the week ending February 20, 1924.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 256 centers, of which 250 are included in the summary by Federal Reserve Districts.
