## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending July 29, aggregated \$10,242,000,000 or 9.1 per cent below the total of \$11,273,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York City reported a reduction of \$449,000,000, while other large reductions are as follows: Detroit \$64,000,000, Boston \$59,000,000, San Francisco \$50,000,000, Chicago \$45,000,000, Cleveland \$25,000,000, Los Angeles \$21,000,000, and Philadelphia and St. Louis \$18,000,000 each. An increase of \$31,000,000 was reported by Pittsburgh.

As compared with the week ending July 30, 1924, debits for the week under review were larger by \$869,000,000 or 9.3 per cent. Substantial increases are shown for most of the more important centers, the principal increases being as follows: New York City \$328,000,000, Chicago \$99,000,000, Pittsburgh \$46,000,000, Detroit \$43,000,000, Cleveland \$30,000,000, Philadelphia \$26,000,000, and St. Louis \$17,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919 were \$9,646,896,000, as compared with \$10,597,458,000 for the preceding week and \$8,828,259,000 for the week ending July 30, 1924.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 257 centers, of which 254 are included in the summary by Federal Reserve Districts.
