BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending October 21, aggregated \$13,194,000,000 or 24 per cent above the total of \$10,664,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York City reported an increase of \$1,626,000,000, Boston \$140,000,000, Chicago \$104,000,000, San Francisco \$75,000,000, Philadelphia \$74,000,000, Detroit \$39,000,000, Los Angeles \$34,000,000, and Cleveland and Pittsburgh \$29,000,000 each.

As compared with the week ending October 22, 1924, debits for the week under review are larger by \$2,382,000,000 or 22 per cent. Substantial increases are shown for most of the more important centers, the principal increases being as follows: New York City \$1,597,000,000, Chicago \$83,000,000, Boston \$81,000,000, Philadelphia \$72,000,000, San Francisco \$63,000,000, Detroit \$58,000,000 and Cleveland \$35,000,000. The largest decreases, \$24,000,000 and \$21,000,000, were reported by Duluth and Minneapolis, respectively.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, amounted to about \$12,431,000,000, as compared with \$10,001,553,000 for the preceding week and \$10,139,857,000 for the week ending October 22, 1924.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 256 centers, of which 253 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
