BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in leading cities for the week ending December 9, aggregated \$12,376,000,000 or 5.8 per cent above the total of \$11,694,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York City reported an increase of \$682,000,000, while the principal reductions were as follows: St. Louis \$36,000,000, Pittsburgh \$33,000,000, Cleveland \$28,000,000 and Boston \$22,000,000.

As compared with the week ending December 10, 1924, debits for the week under review are larger by \$1,167,000,000 or 10.4 per cent. Substantial increases were reported by most of the more important centers, the principal increases being as follows: New York City \$628,000,000, Boston \$52,000,000, San Francisco \$47,000,000, Chicago \$40,000,000, Detroit \$35,000,000, St. Louis \$20,000,000, Baltimore \$19,000,000, and Pittsburgh and Los Angeles \$13,000,000 each.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, amounted to \$11,598,504,000, as compared with \$10,978,995,000 for the preceding week and \$10,531,892,000 for the week ending December 10, 1924.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 257 centers, of which 256 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
