BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts as reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in leading cities for the week ending December 23, aggregated \$13,172,000,000 or 4.7 per cent below the total of \$13,827,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York City reported a reduction of \$334,000,000, San Francisco - \$101,000,000, Philadelphia - \$68,000,000, Chicago - \$33,000,000, and Boston \$31,000,000. The largest increase, \$32,000,000, was reported by Detroit.

As compared with the week ending December 24, 1924, debits for the week under review are larger by \$1,757,000,000 or 15.4 per cent. Substantial increases were reported by most of the more important centers, the principal increases being as follows: New York City \$1,007,000,000, Detroit \$82,000,000, Chicago \$64,000,000, San Francisco \$48,000,000, Boston \$42,000,000, Los Angeles \$30,000,000, Philadelphia \$26,000,000, and St. Louis \$24,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, amounted to \$12,405,389,000, as compared with \$13,043,339,000 for the preceding week and \$10,725,861,000 for the week ending December 24, 1924.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 255 centers, of which 254 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
