## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board for in leading cities for the week ending February 10, aggregated 107,000,000 or 9.5 per cent below the total of \$13,373,000,000 reported for preceding week. New York City reported a decline of \$821,000,000 while other reductions were as follows: Boston \$106,000,000, Philadelphia \$75,000,000, Pittsburgh \$31,000,000, Detroit \$21,000,000 and Cleveland, Baltimore and St. Louis 1,000,000 each. The largest increase, \$75,000,000, was reported by San Francisco.

As compared with the week ending February 11, 1925, debits for the week under review are larger by \$870,000,000 or 7.7 per cent. Increases were reported for most of the more important centers, the largest increases being as follows: New York City \$171,000,000, San Francisco \$134,000,000, Chicago \$107,000,000, Philadelphia \$55,000,000, Los Angeles \$26,000,000, and Detroit \$22,000,000. Pittsburgh reported a reduction of \$33,000,000, Boston - of \$36,000,000, and Minneapolis - of 1,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly in January, 1919, amounted to about \$11,426,000,000 as compared with \$10,197,000 for the preceding week and \$10,591,710,000 for the week ending January 11, 1925.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for in 257 centers, of which are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
