BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board for the week ending March 17, aggregated \$13,643,000,000 or 9.6 per cent above the total of \$13,009,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York City reported an increase of \$92,000,000, while other large increases were as follows: Chicago \$74,000,000, Boston \$72,000,000, Detroit \$44,000,000, Philadelphia \$40,000,000, St. Louis \$34,000,000, San Francisco \$32,000,000, Los Angeles \$20,000,000, Cleveland \$24,000,000 and Milwaukee \$21,000,000.

As compared with the week ending March 18, 1925, debits for the week under review are larger by \$1,190,000,000 or 9.6 per cent. Increases were reported by most of the more important centers, the largest increases being as follows: New York \$114,000,000, Boston \$82,000,000, San Francisco \$47,000,000, Los Angeles \$30,000,000 and Detroit \$25,000,000. Reductions of \$40,000,000 and \$25,000,000 were reported by Chicago and Minneapolis, respectively.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919, amounted to \$12,905,451,000 as compared with \$12,306,338,000 for the preceding week and \$11,741,443,000 for the week ending March 18, 1925.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for the week ending March 17, 1926, in 258 centers, all of which are included in the summary by Federal Reserve Districts.
