BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board for the week ending April 14, aggregated \$11,865,000,000, or 14.4 per cent less than the total of \$13,367,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York City reported a decline of \$1,114,000,000, while other large reductions were as follows: Boston \$135,000,000, Chicago \$80,000,000, New Orleans \$65,000,000, St. Louis \$30,000,000 and San Francisco \$22,000,000. The largest increase, \$58,000,000, was reported by Philadelphia.

As compared with the week ending April 15, 1925, debits for the week under review are larger by \$1,489,000,000 or 14.4 per cent. Increases are shown for most of the more important centers, the largest increases being as follows: New York \$11,165,000,000, Philadelphia \$102,000,000, Chicago \$41,000,000, San Francisco \$25,000,000 and Los Angeles \$23,000,000. Reductions of \$25,000,000 and \$20,000,000 were reported by Cleveland and St. Louis, respectively.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, amounted to \$11,117,296,000, as compared with \$12,557,130,000 for the preceding week and \$9,690,630,000 for the week ending April 15, 1925.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for 257 centers, all of which are included in the summary by Federal Reserve districts.
