## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board for leading cities for the week ending May 26, aggregated \$11,518,000,000 or 1.1 per cent below the total of \$11,978,000,000 reported for the previous week.

Debits for the week under review are \$451,000,000 or 4.1 per cent above those for the week ending May 27, 1925, increases being reported for most of the larger centers. The principal increases were as follows: New York City, \$113,000,000, Chicago \$79,000,000, Pittsburgh \$36,000,000, and San Francisco \$23,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published since January, 1919, amounted to \$10,846,284,000, as compared with \$10,826,000 for the preceding week and \$10,429,588,000 for the week ending May 27, 1925.
