## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board in leading cities for the week ending July 7, aggregated \$12,366,000,000 or 1.2 per cent below the total of \$12,639,000,000 reported for the preceding week.

Debits for the week under review are \$1,195,000,000 or 10.7 per cent above those for the week ending July 8, 1925. New York City reported an increase of \$100,000,000, while other large increases were as follows: Boston \$78,000,000, Chicago \$72,000,000, Philadelphia \$53,000,000, Baltimore \$38,000,000, Detroit \$30,000,000, Los Angeles \$32,000,000, Cleveland \$31,000,000, San Francisco \$25,000,000 and Buffalo \$24,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919, amounted to \$11,563,457,000, as compared with \$11,906,342,000 for the preceding week and \$10,472,762,000 for the week ending July 8, 1925.
