## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by  
in leading cities for the week ending July 21, aggregated \$12,253,000,000  
compared with a total of \$12,239,000,000 reported for the preceding week.

Debits for the week under review are \$965,000,000 or 8.6 per cent above  
for the week ending July 22, 1925. New York City reported an increase  
\$1,000,000, while other large increases were as follows: Boston  
\$1,000,000, Chicago \$44,000,000, Los Angeles \$36,000,000, and Philadelphia  
\$1,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published  
since January 1919, amounted to \$11,470,519,000, as compared with  
\$10,529,000 for the preceding week and \$10,597,458,000 for the week ending  
July 22, 1925.
