## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by  
in leading cities for the week ending July 28, aggregated \$10,954,000,000,  
per cent below the total of \$12,255,000,000 reported for the preceding

Debits for the week under review are \$700,000,000, or 6.8 per cent above  
for the week ending July 29, 1925. New York City reported an increase of  
\$100,000,000, while other large increases were as follows: San Francisco  
\$100,000,000, Chicago \$37,000,000, Boston \$34,000,000, Los Angeles \$30,000,000,  
\$18,000,000, and Philadelphia and Detroit \$17,000,000 each.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published  
since January 1919, amounted to \$10,282,104,000, as compared with  
\$10,519,000 for the preceding week and \$9,646,896,000 for the week ending  
29, 1925.
